- Information regarding financial supports including CERB (Canada Emergency Response Benefit), CRB (Canada Recovery Benefit), EI, CCB (Canada Child Benefit), social assistance, pensions and others
- Guidance on completion of application forms such as permanent resident card, citizenship, work permits and sponsorship
