The Pathways to Early Childhood Education is a 12-week online program which includes:

- First Aid /CPR level C Certificate (3-day in-person training)
- Food Handling Training Certificate
- 8-week online ECE language training
- 4-week in-person paid Work Placement with a licensed Child Care Centre in York Region
- Individual career assessment and planning
- Job Search Skills; Resume Writing & Interview Skills
- WES Credential Evaluation and Accreditation assistance
- Translation of Degree
- Connection to Early Childhood Educators and Associations of Early Childhood Education Ontario

Eligibility Criteria:

- Newcomers - Permanent Residents, Convention Refugees, Refugee Claimants with work permit or naturalized Canadian Citizens.
- Professional experience from outside Canada as Early Childhood Educators, Preschool Teachers & Primary Teachers, or possess a Bachelors' of Arts Degree in other related fields is an asset but not required.
- English proficiency: CLB Level 5+
- Must be a resident of York Region.

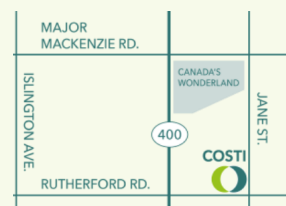
