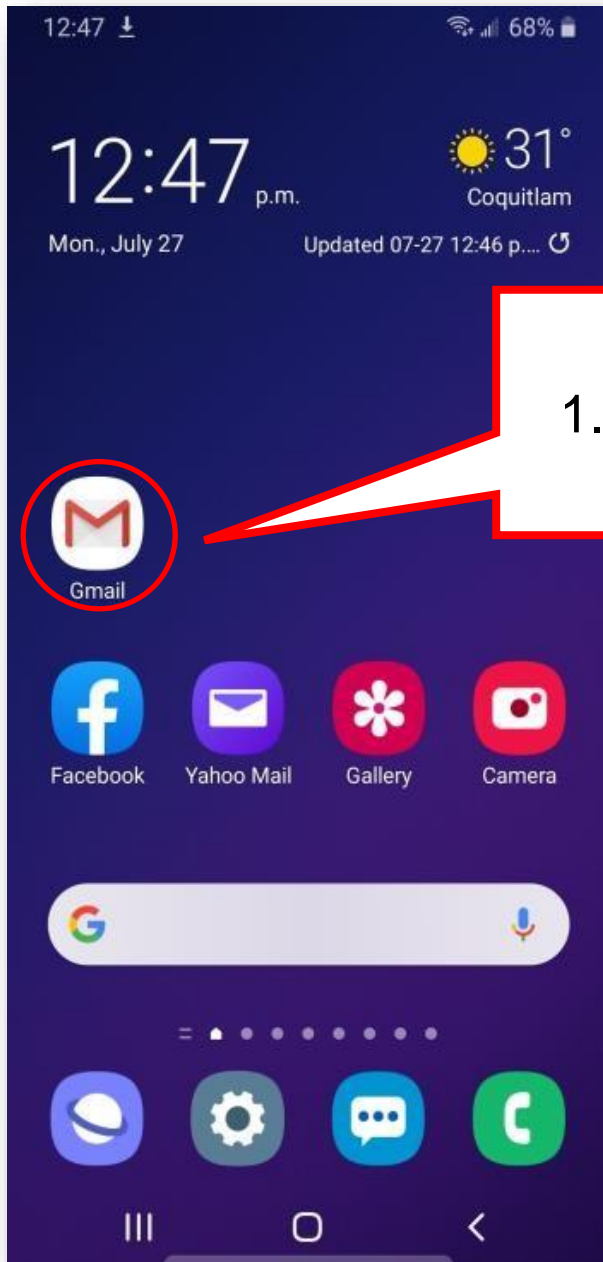


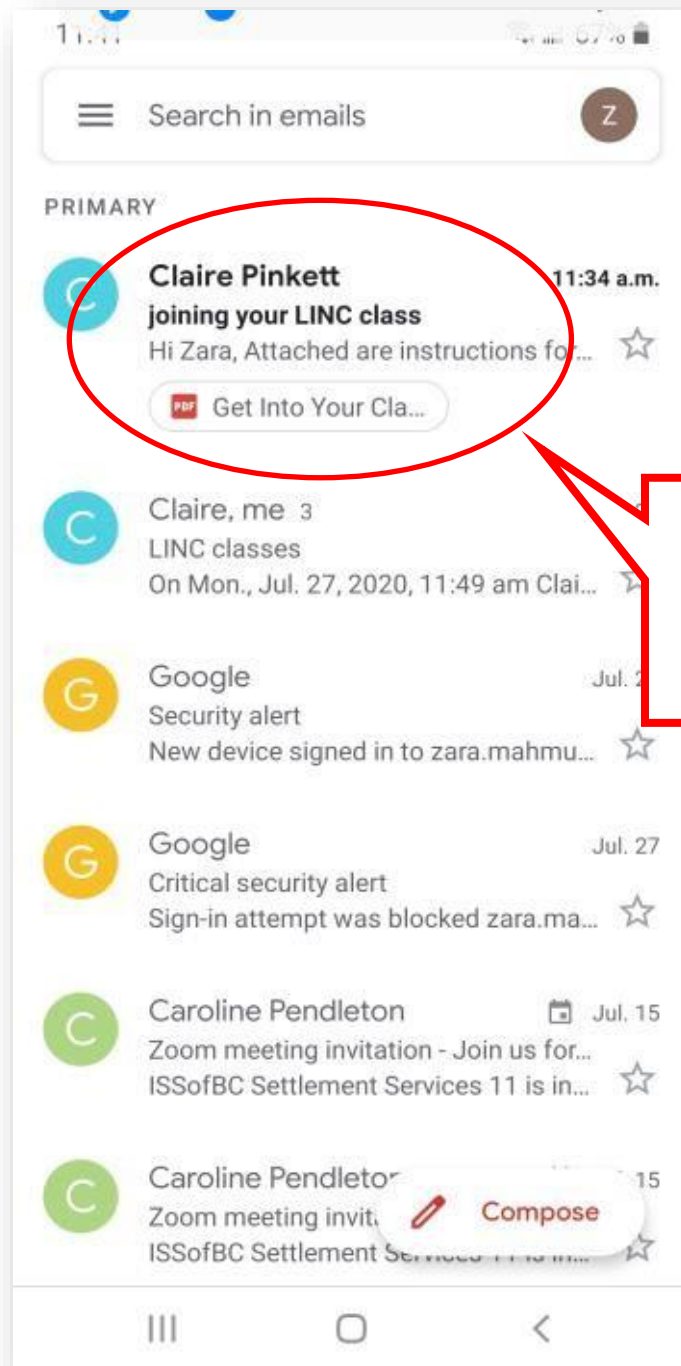

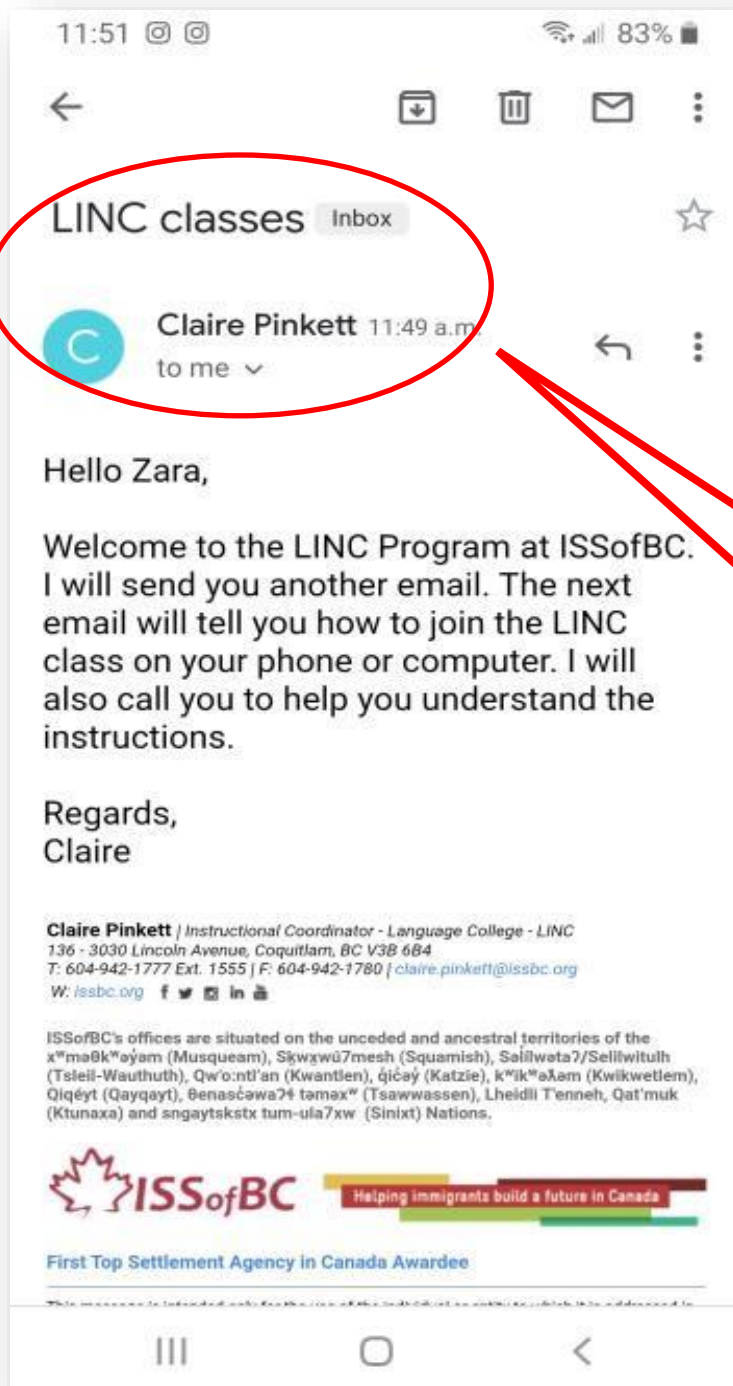
1. Tap Gmail

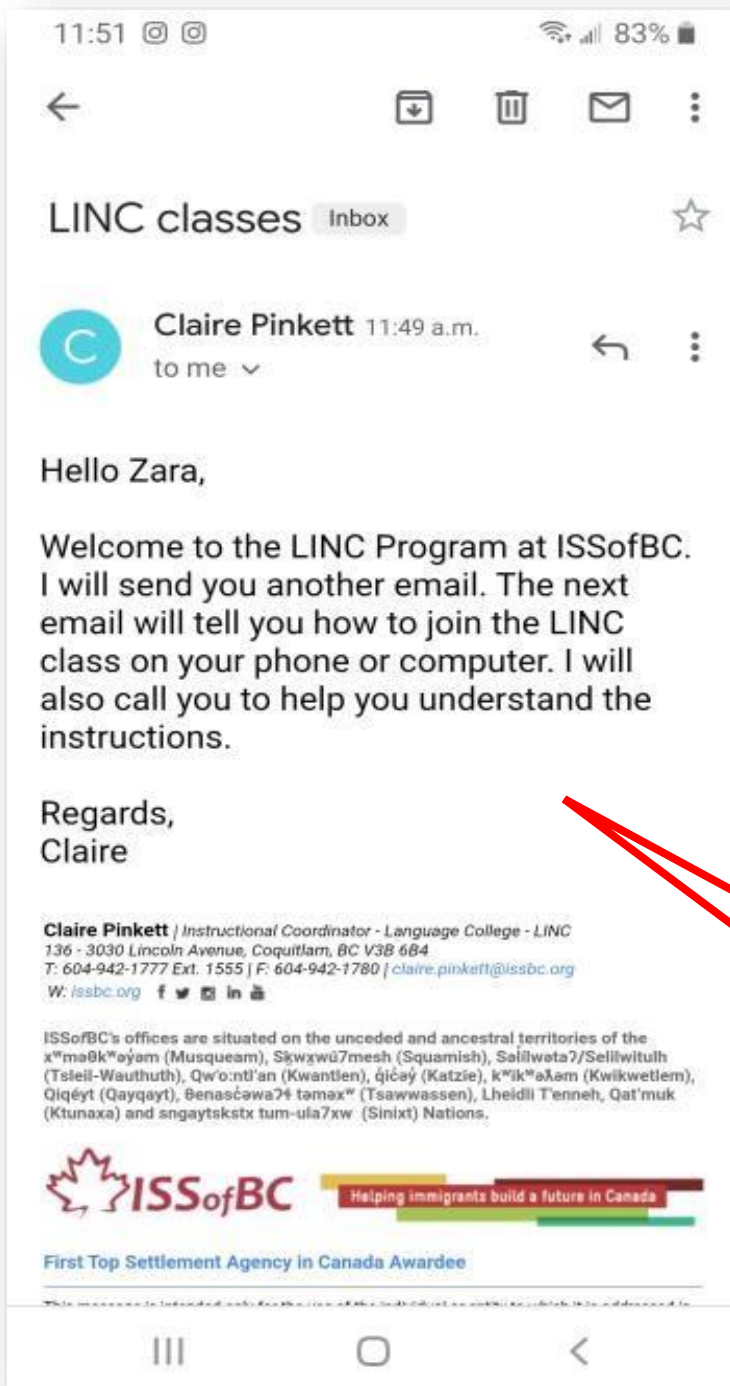

5. Class Procedures and Guidelines:

1. **Attendance:** You need to be there at least 80% of the time. If you can't make it, let your teacher or me know in advance.
2. **Participation:** You should participate in your class discussions, complete your assignments on time, and answer your teacher's questions.
3. **ePortfolio:** Your work on Avenue shows how you're doing in class. Make sure to finish all the work your teacher gives you on Avenue on time.
4. **Camera Policy:** In online classes, it's important to keep your camera on all the time, just like you would in a real classroom. If something urgent comes up, you can turn it off for a very short time. But if your teacher asks you to join in and you're not there, it'll count as an absence.
