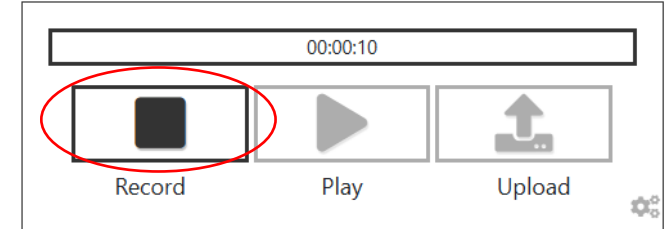

2. After finishing record, Click 'Record' button again.



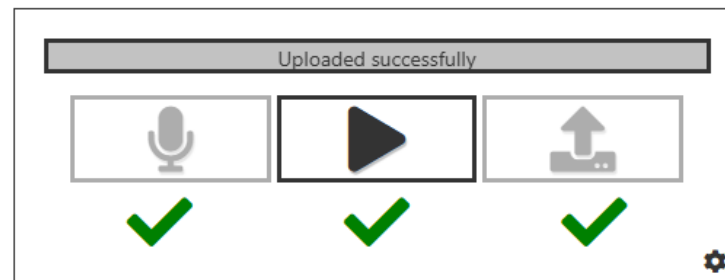
3. Click 'Play' button to check your voice.
